What does ARC do?

ARC offers your patients navigation services that can connect them to health and social resources available in their community.

What navigation services can patients receive?



- Accessed online or by telephone
- Available in over 150 languages
- Repertoire of over 60,000 community resources in our region
- Informs and orients individuals to the available resources in their community





PATIENT NAVIGATOR

- Accessed in person, by telephone, e-mail, or text
- Available in French and English
- Uses existing navigation tools (e.g., Ontario 211)
- Informs and orients individuals to the available resources in their community
- Helps individuals overcome barriers and access community resources :
- Arranges transportation
- Makes appointments
- Provides/organizes translation
- Provides administrative support completing forms)
- Helps patients access funding
- Identifies culturally appropriate resources
- Arranges caregiver services
- Accompanies patients to the service or program


